HOME ENERGY & WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

The **Weatherization Assistance Program** and the **Energy Assistance Program (EAP)** work together to help permanently reduce the energy bills for low-income Minnesotans.

The **Weatherization Assistance Program** provides free home energy upgrades to income-eligible homeowners and renters to help save energy and make sure your home is a healthy and safe place to live.

The **Energy Assistance Program (EAP)** helps pay for home heating costs for income-qualified households.

In addition to these two programs, **Energy Related Repair (ERR) Programs** may be able to assist with emergency repair or replacement of non-functional or unsafe heating systems. Access to these resources varies by County.

Energy Related Repair (ERR) Program

If you are an Energy Assistance eligible homeowner and are without heat or have an unsafe heating system, you may qualify for assistance.

Funding is available in late October or early November and will last until resources are spent. Before contacting a furnace professional, call us at 651-645-6470.

This program provides emergency repair or replacement of broken/non-functioning heating systems (ex. furnace) for Energy Assistance clients.

To be eligible for assistance with your heating system you must submit an Energy Assistance Application and be approved.
